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**SCHOOL BOARD
REORGANIZATION MEETING
Minutes
December 1, 2003**

The Reorganization meeting of the Unionville-Chadds Ford School Board was held on Monday, December 1, 2003 in the Unionville High School LGI.

Mrs. Brown, Secretary, called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. She requested that the group stand for the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

A roll call vote of the holdover members was taken with the following members present: Kathleen Brown, Secretary, Keith Knauss, Ed Murray, and student representative, Solny Adalsteinsson. Mrs. Brown stated that Dr. Corinne Sweeney was given the Oath of Office by an elected official of the state of Pennsylvania and is also a member of our Board. A copy of the notary's letter stating that she has seen the official Certificate of Election and has administered the Oath of Office to Dr. Sweeney is attached. New and reelected Board members were seated for the election of a President.
