Frequently Asked Questions about the Food Service Program

HOW MUCH IS A MEAL? The school meal price will be voted on at the August 18th board meeting. The anticipated prices for 09-10 are as follows: A school breakfast meal- \$1.25 (middle/high school). School lunch meal-\$2.00 (elementary) and \$2.25-\$3.00 (middle school/high school). The meal price includes the entrée, all side items, and milk.

WHAT IF MY CHILD WANTS TO BUY JUST MILK AND/OR SNACKS? Milk, Bottled Water and Lemonade are available on the lunch lines for 60 cents each. Snacks include soft pretzels, ice cream novelties, regular chips and baked chips at a cost 60 cents each. The middle school and high school offer additional snack items at various prices which are posted in the cafeteria.

WHAT IS POINT OF SALE? A Point of Sale is a system that will allow the cafeteria to meet certain federal guidelines regarding menu planning and service. It is also used to eliminate the need for cash on a daily basis thereby speeding up meal service. An account is set up for every student so that he/she can purchase a meal or other items in the cafeteria without having to bring cash everyday. The parent sends in money to be placed in the student's account. As the student purchases lunch or other items, the system will automatically deduct the amount from the account.

DO I HAVE CONTROL OVER THE AMOUNT SPENT IN THE CAFETERIA? Parents predetermine whether a child can use the money/account for "meals only" or for "meals and ala carte" purchases. Ala carte purchases can be milk, water, chips, ice cream, etc. The parent determines how the account may be used when it is set up. An account balance and record of money submitted and spent can be obtained easily by calling the cafeteria at the school.

HOW DOES MY CHILD USE THE POINT OF SALE SYSTEM? Each student is given either a card (elementary grades K-3) or their 6-digit identification number (elementary grades 4-5, all middle school students, all high school students) that they must use at the end of the serving line whether they are using their account or if they are paying cash. This is a federal regulation. This will bring up their account on the screen. The cashier will key in what the student selected. If the student is using money from their account, the computer will deduct the purchase and the student just goes to their seat to enjoy their purchases. If the student pays cash, the computer will calculate the purchase and the cashier will collect the money from the student and give them change if needed.

HOW DO I KNOW THAT MY CHILD IS THE ONLY ONE USING THE ACCOUNT? The system will prompt the cashier if a number has been entered more than once. The system also displays the student's picture so the cashier can easily identify that the correct student is making the purchases.

WHAT IF MY CHILD DOESN'T HAVE ENOUGH MONEY IN HIS ACCOUNT WHEN HE GOES THROUGH THE LINE? At the elementary level, students will be able to choose a meal and the meal will be charged on their account. A letter will then be sent home so that the parent can repay the charge. After 3 charges, the parent will be contacted personally to repay the debt. Low balance letters are also sent when an account falls below the \$5.00 mark so that the parent can replenish the account before it is at a zero or negative balance. The student may also pay cash at the end of the line. At the middle school and high school level, the student may charge 1 meal. No ala carte purchases may be charged at any grade level.

WHAT IF MY CHILD HAS SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES? If your child has an allergy or medical condition of which we should be aware, you may indicate that on the prepayment envelope and the nurse at the school will send you the appropriate form to be completed by your physician. At your request, the system can discretely alert the cashier when your child goes through the line if you feel they may need assistance.

HOW DO I SET UP AN ACCOUNT FOR MY CHILD? Every student is given an identification number and an account in the point of sale system. To activate the account, you only need to fill in the payment envelope, enclose cash or a check made payable to "UCF Cafeteria" and have your child take it to the cafeteria. If you do not have a payment envelope, just use any envelope and mark the outside with your child's full name, grade, and teacher. Please make sure your child's first and last name is on the check. The cafeteria manager will call you if there are any questions.

IS THERE A LIMIT TO THE AMOUNT OF MONEY I CAN PUT IN THE ACCOUNT? If your child purchases lunch or other items from the cafeteria fairly often, you may want to put a minimum of \$25.00 in their account. There is no set limit to the amount of money that can be placed in the account. The system will accept any amount that you feel is appropriate.

WHAT IF I CHOOSE NOT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE POINT OF SALE? You have the option of paying cash on the serving line each day. However, each student still needs to get his/her card (elem) or use their pin number (ms/hs) prior to making any kind of purchase.

WHAT IF I CAN'T AFFORD TO MAKE ANY PURCHASES IN THE CAFETERIA? The UCFSB participates in the Free/Reduced Price Meal Program. An application is sent home with each child every year. If you complete the application and return it to school, it will be processed and you will be notified if you are approved for either free or reduced price meals.
