Guidelines</p>	<p>The Superintendent or designee shall develop and disseminate procedures to implement the extracurricular activities program.</p> <p><del>Guidelines shall ensure that the program of extracurricular activities:</del></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><del>1. Assesses the needs and interests of and is responsive to district students.</del></li> <li><del>2. Involves students in developing and planning extracurricular activities.</del></li> <li><del>3. Ensures provision of competent guidance and supervision by staff.</del></li> <li><del>4. Guards against exploitation of students.</del></li> <li><del>5. Provides for continuing evaluation of the program and its components.</del></li> <li><del>6. Ensures that all extracurricular activities are open to all students and that all students are fully informed of the opportunities open to them.</del></li> </ol> <p><b>The Superintendent or designee shall prepare guidelines and rules in the following areas:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>A. Sec. 4071 et seq.</p>	<p><u>Equal Access Act</u></p> <p>The district shall provide secondary students the opportunity for noncurriculum related student groups to meet on the school premises during noninstructional time for the purpose of conducting a meeting within the limited open forum on the basis of religious, political, philosophical, or other content of the speech at such meetings. Such meetings must be voluntary, student-initiated, and not sponsored in any way by the school, its agents or employees. <b>Noninstructional time</b> is the time set aside by the school before actual classroom instruction begins or after actual classroom instruction ends.</p> <p>The meetings cannot materially and substantially interfere with the orderly conduct of the educational activities in the school.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall establish the length of sessions, number per week, and other limitations deemed reasonably necessary.</p>
