

Health and Safety Plan Summer 2021

Unionville-Chadds Ford School District

This plan goes into effect at 2:00 pm June 16 and ends at 6:00 am August 30

Cleaning, Sanitizing, Disinfecting, and Ventilation

- Routine cleaning of any utilized spaces will be performed each afternoon.
 Additional cleaning will be implemented on an as needed basis.
- Portable HEPA air purifiers will be provided for all classrooms and small office spaces to further enhance clean air exchange rates and improve IAQ.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be maintained in each entrance area, and students and staff will be encouraged to use them before entering the buildings.
- Touch-free wall mounted hand sanitizer dispensers will be maintained throughout the buildings and in classrooms.
- Water drinking fountains will continue to be turned off. Water filling stations will be available. Students and staff are encouraged to bring their own water bottles.

Safety Protocols

- From June 16 through June 27, all adults and students must wear masks while on school property or when using school vehicles unless they are fully vaccinated or they have a documented medical condition that would prevent the wearing of a mask. Any staff member or student engaging in high exertion OUTDOOR activities including, but not limited to, athletics, exercise, or play activities is NOT required to wear a mask when actively engaged in those activities. Adults and students that are not vaccinated can take off their masks outside if they are maintaining at least 6 feet of social distancing. After June 27, no masks are required based on the Governor's orders and Chester County Health Department recommendations. However, unvaccinated staff members and students are encouraged to wear a mask while indoors.
- All bus drivers, staff, and students must wear masks while on the school bus.
 Drivers do not need to wear a mask if they are the only person on the bus.



ESY, Summer Academy, Athletics, and Activities

- From June 16 through June 27, students and staff will wear masks indoors and outdoors unless fully vaccinated as stated above. After June 27, masks are not required, however unvaccinated individuals (staff and students) are encouraged to wear a mask while indoors.
- Students will have assigned seats in the classroom and on the bus to facilitate contact tracing if necessary.
- Snacks must be individual and prepackaged; no sharing permitted.

Monitoring Student and Staff Health

- School nurses will follow CCHD guidance related to communicable diseases including <u>COVID-19</u>.
- Students and staff should report any exposures to COVID-19 or positive test results to the school nursing staff and/or to the coaching/athletic staff.
- The school district will maintain adequate personal protective equipment for use by staff.

Additional Considerations

• Fall sports team practices will begin on August 9, 2021. Adjustments to this plan for fall sports teams may be made for the August 9 - August 30 time period.
